5. Safety tracking: Permit tracking of daily commutes or travels.

6. Threat detection: Identify potential threats or suspicious behavior.

7. Support network: Connect women with a support network or community.
-
8. Resource access: Provide access to relevant resources, such as legal aid or counseling.
-
9. Awareness: Raise awareness about women's safety and rights
-
10. Empowerment: Empower women to take control of their safety and well-being.

11. Anonymous reporting: Allow anonymous reporting of harassment or abuse.
12. Personalized safety plans: Offer personalized safety plans based on individual needs.
13. Integration with wearable devices: Integrate with wearable devices for added safety.
14. Real-time alerts: Send real-time alerts to emergency contacts or authorities.
15. Data analysis: Analyze data to identify patterns and improve safety measures.

These objectives aim to create a comprehensive and supportive ecosystem for women's safety and empowerment.

Principal Dr. V.R. Jyotsna Kumari Explained to the students - Now a days women and children of all ages are facing violence, discrimination and sexual harassment at home and work places. Government of India and all state Governments have established various help line centers and apps for the protection and safety of women and children. A wide spread awareness campaigns are conducted across the country are conducted to bring awareness about these helpline centers.

Brief description of the programme: **Mr. Sridhar Babu** explained to the students - Women safety apps are mobile applications designed to ensure women's safety and security. These apps offer various features such as:

- Panic buttons or emergency alerts
- Location sharing or tracking
- Safety networks or community support
- Anonymous reporting of harassment or abuse
- Personalized safety plans

- Integration with wearable devices
- Real-time alerts to emergency contacts or authorities

Objective: The objectives of cybercrime can vary depending on the type of crime and the motivations of the perpetrator. Some common objectives of cybercrime include:

1. Financial gain: Stealing money or valuable information for personal profit.
 2. Data theft: Stealing sensitive information such as personal data, intellectual property, or trade secrets.
 3. Disruption: Causing harm or disruption to computer systems, networks, or critical infrastructure.
1. Espionage: Spying on individuals, organizations, or governments to gain sensitive information.
 2. Extortion: Demanding payment or other concessions in exchange for not releasing sensitive information or restoring access to data.
 3. Identity theft: Stealing personal information to impersonate individuals or gain access to their accounts.

4. Reputation damage: Damaging an individual's or organization's reputation through cyberbullying, defamation, or other means.
5. Political motivations: Using cybercrime to influence political outcomes, disrupt elections, or spread propaganda.
6. Personal revenge: Using cybercrime to exact revenge on individuals or organizations.
7. Thrill-seeking: Engaging in cybercrime for excitement or challenge.
8. Resale: Stealing data or resources to resell on the black market.
9. Competitive advantage: Using cybercrime to gain an unfair advantage over competitors.
10. Sabotage: Disrupting or destroying computer systems or data to harm an organization.
11. Terrorism: Using cybercrime to support or facilitate terrorist activities.
12. State-sponsored: Conducting cybercrime on behalf of a government or nation-state to achieve strategic objectives.

It's important to note that these objectives are not mutually exclusive, and cybercriminals may have multiple motivations for their actions.

Principal Dr. V.R. Jyotsna Kumari - explained to the students - Cyber-crime awareness programs are essential to educate individuals and organizations about the risks and consequences of cyber-crime. Educating people about cyber threats and how to prevent them, Raising awareness about the latest cyber-attacks and scams, Providing knowledge on how to protect personal and sensitive information online, Promoting safe online practices and digital literacy.

Brief description of the programme: Sri G. Lakshmaiah, DSP, CID RO explained to the students - Cybercrime refers to the use of computers, devices, or the internet to commit criminal offenses, such as:

- Hacking
- Phishing
- Identity theft
- Online harassment
- Cyberstalking
- Ransomware attacks
- Data breaches
- Credit card fraud
- Online scams
- Child pornography
- Digital espionage

Cybercrime can be committed by individuals, groups, or state-sponsored actors, and can result in financial losses, reputational damage, and emotional distress for victims. It's a growing concern for individuals, businesses, and governments, as more aspects of life become digital.

Some common forms of cybercrime include:

- Malware attacks
- Social engineering
- Denial of Service (DoS) attacks
- SQL injection attacks

- Cross-site scripting (XSS) attacks
- Cyberbullying
- Online fraud

Sri Ch. Adinarayana Addl., S.P., R.O., Guntur, explained to the students – About the Online Crime cases he solved.

Smt. Kavitha, SI of Police, Cyber Crime, CID, HQ explained to the students - About how to complain to the police with evidences.
