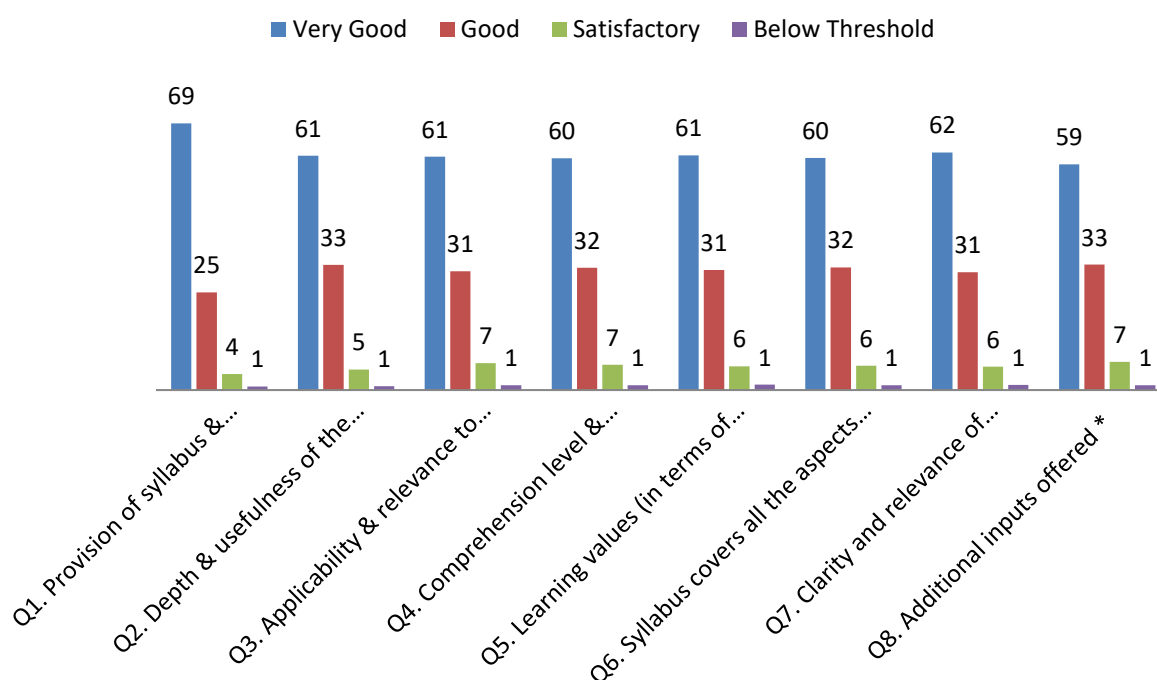

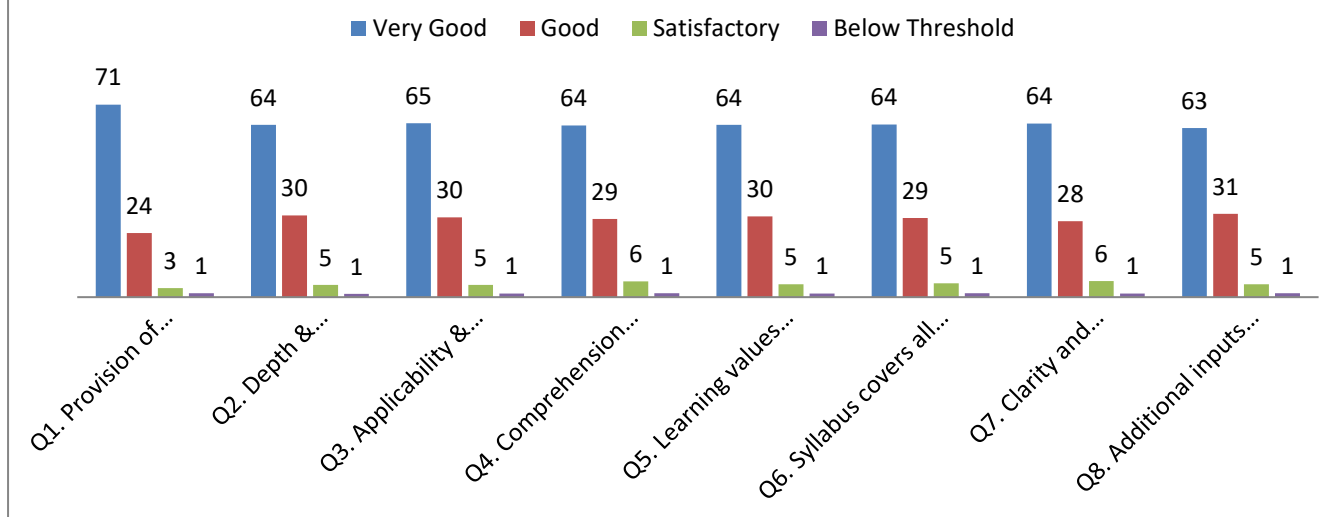

Feedback Analysis on Curriculum by Students on Semester II - 2021-22



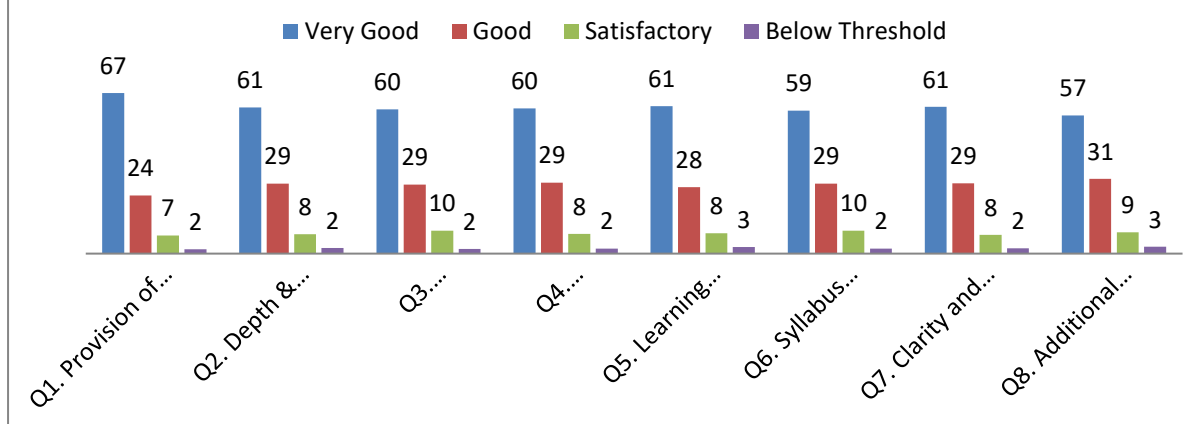

Feedback Analyses on Curriculum by Students on Semester III - 2021-22



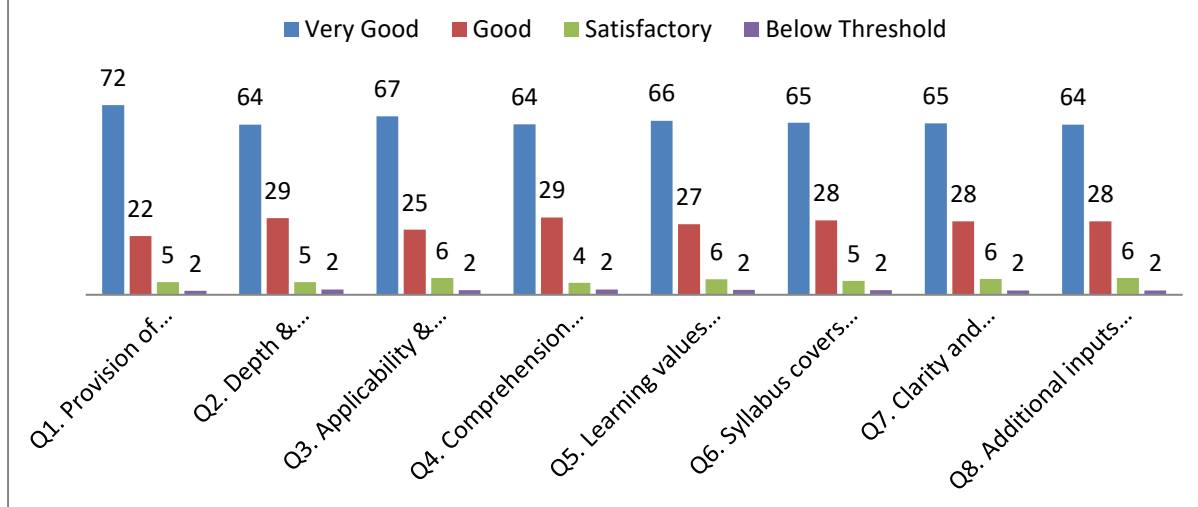

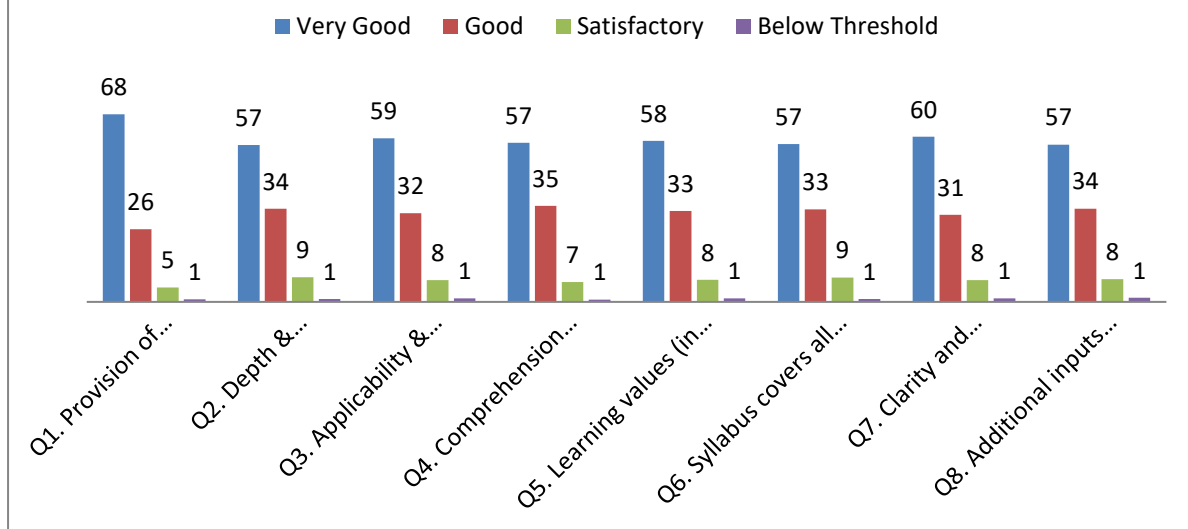

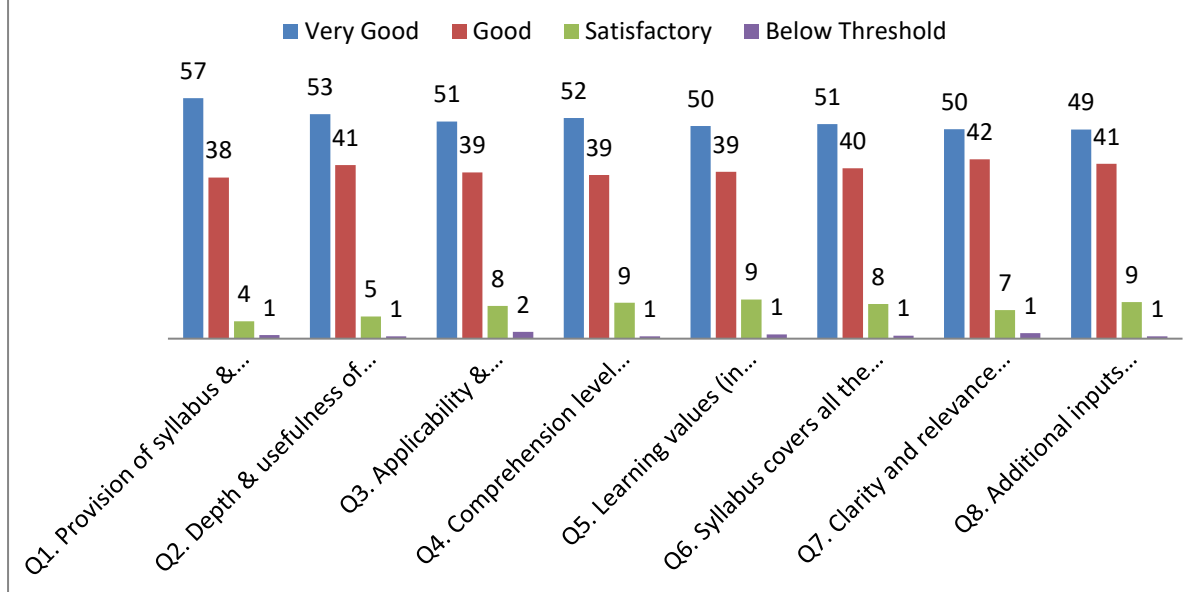
