Outcome: Cadets were inspired to practice yoga and incorporate it into their daily lives.



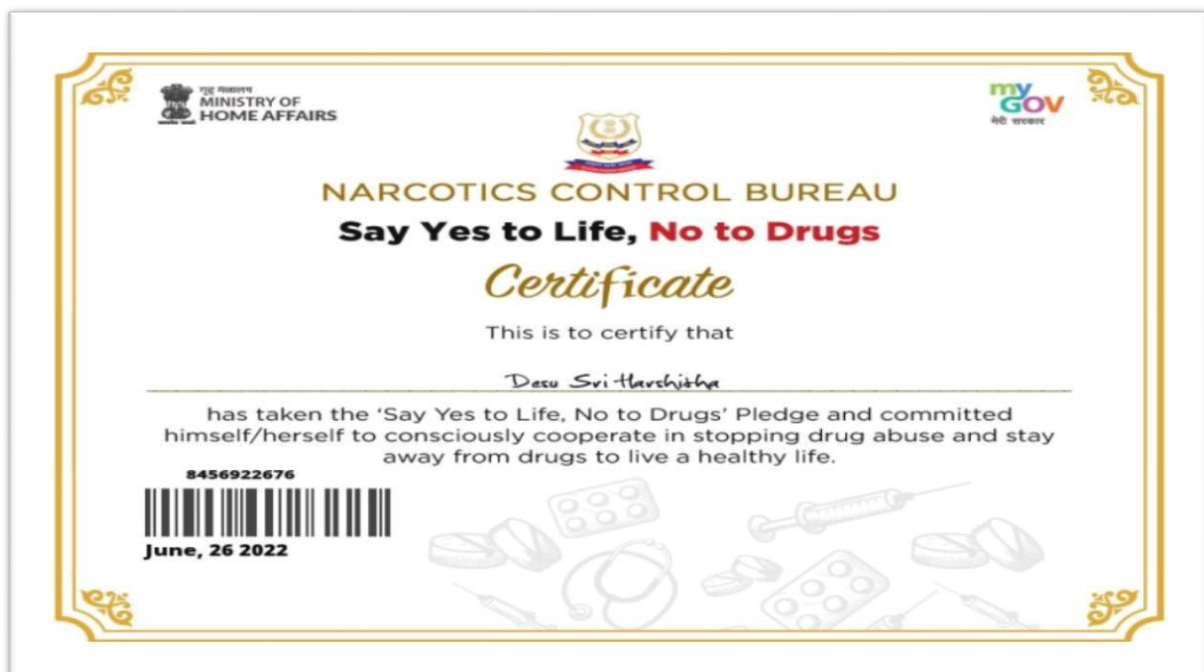
Activity No 4: International Day against Drug Abuse & Illicit Trafficking

Activity No 10: Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC)-VI

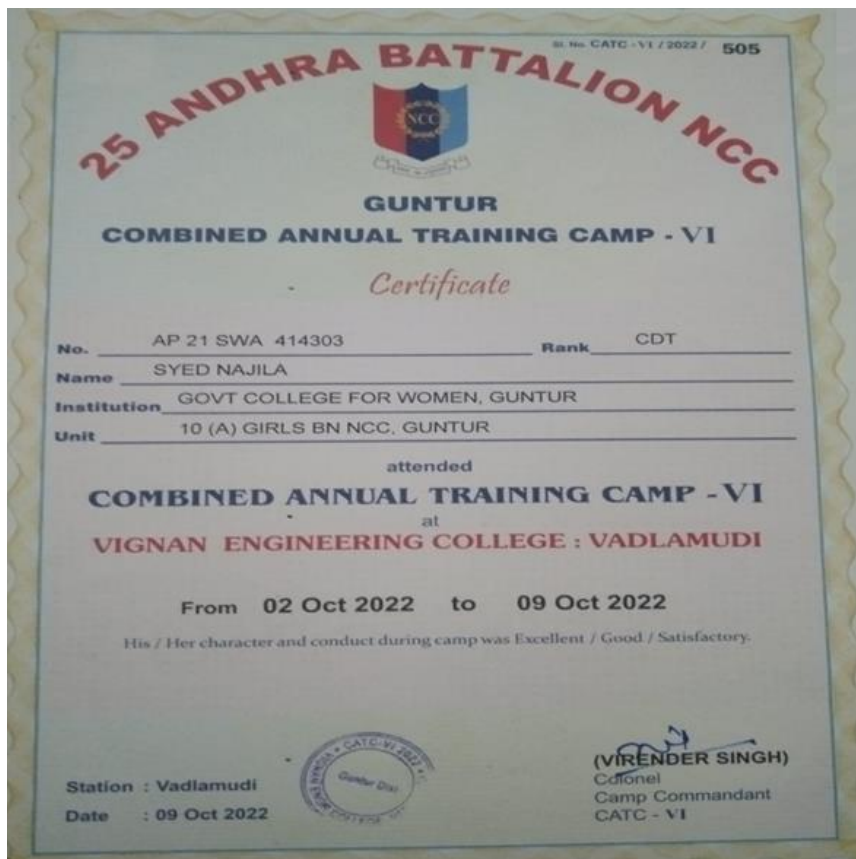
Objectives: To equip the cadets with the drill, arm drill, leadership skills required to appear for the certificate exams

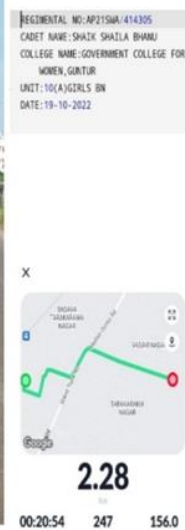
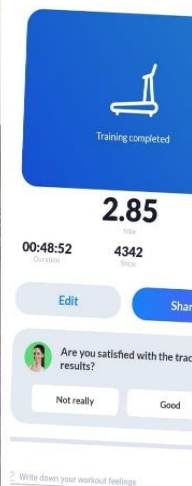


Activity No 12: Fit India Freedom Run (Fit India movement: 2022-2023)

Activity No 14: Piloting in HINDU COLLEGE OF PHARMACY for the graduation ceremony

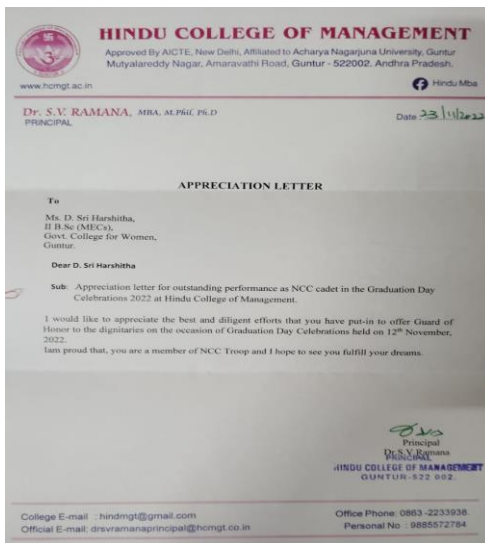

Outcome: Cadets got an opportunity to improve their leadership skills and maintained discipline among the crowd.



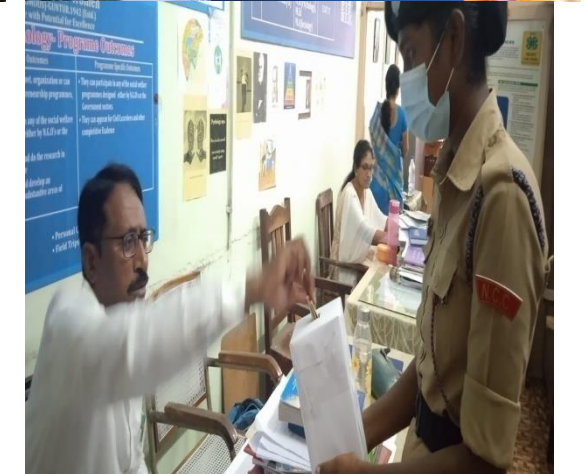
Activity No 16: Communal Harmony Campaign Week and Flag Day 2022

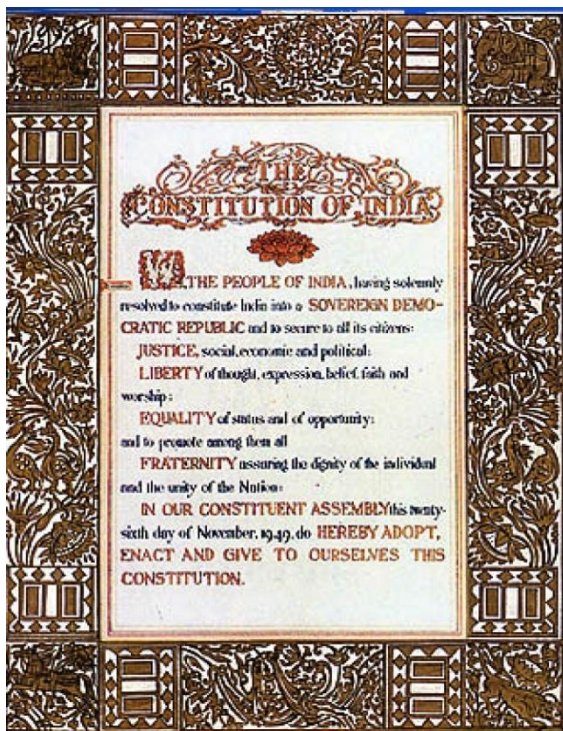


Activity No 18: Constitution Day celebrations

Outcome: Total 45 cadets have participated with enthusiasm in poster presentation and created awareness by making beautiful and meaning full posters with a message.

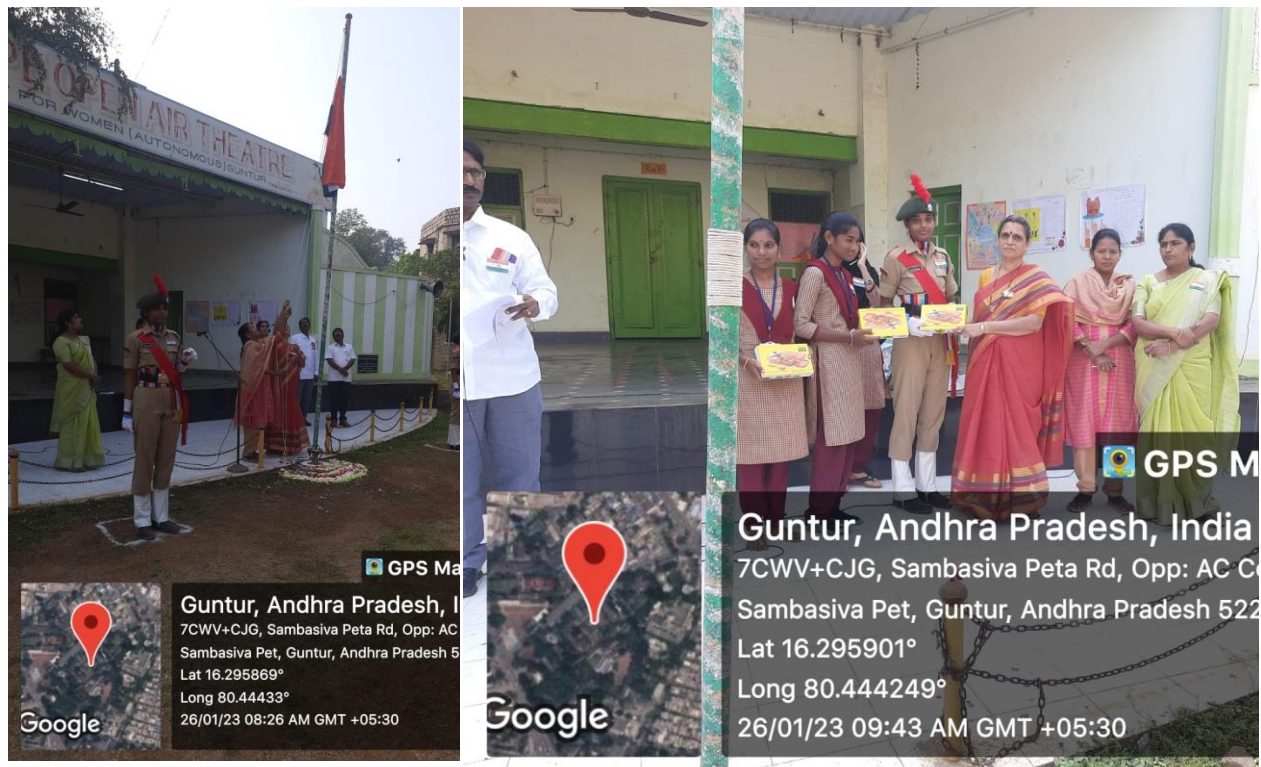


Activity No 22: Republic Day Contingent at GCW
