Activity-1 International Yoga Day Celebrations 2021

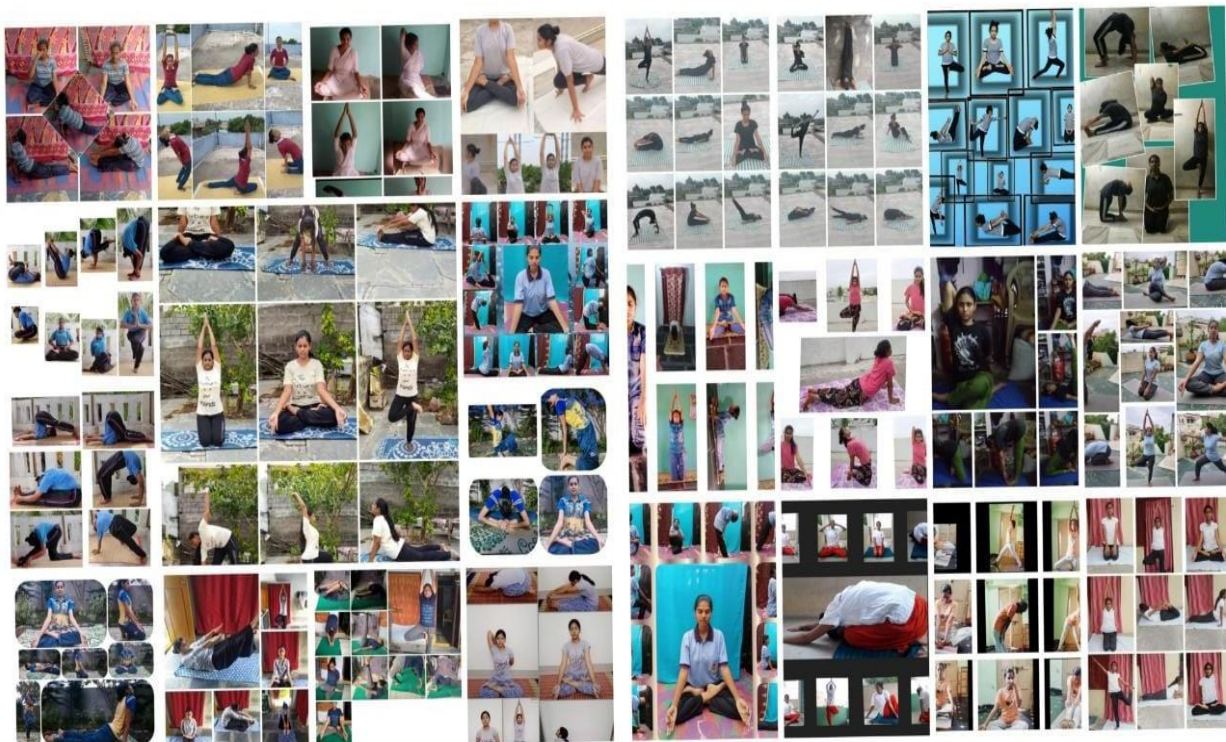
Objective: To perform Yoga asanaas on the International Yoga Day at Home with Family.

Activity-3 fit India freedom run 2.0 (Fit India movement: 2021-2022)

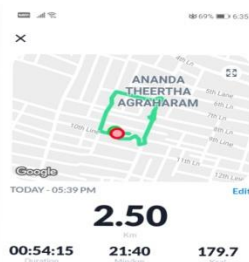
Objectives: To create awareness of being fit and making India fit.

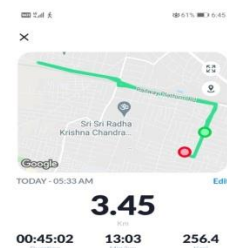
Outcome: Cadets gained and improved their fitness, encouraged others and leading to the healthy and fit India.

Activity -6 Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC)-I

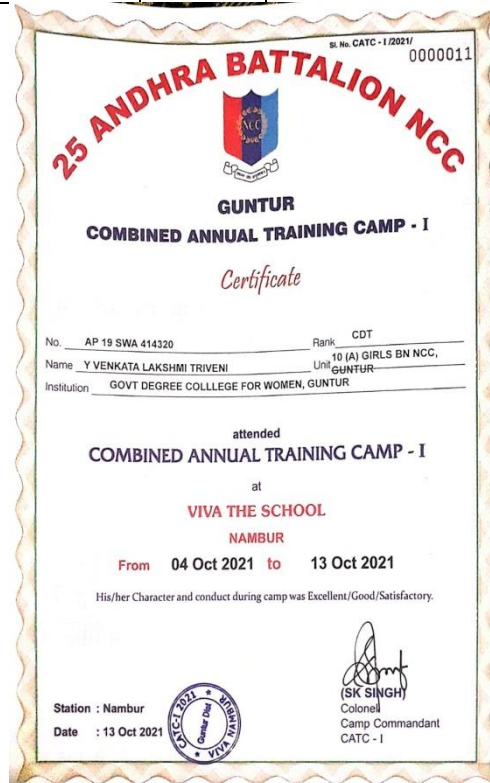
Objectives: To equip the cadets with the drill, arm drill, leadership skills required to appear for the certificate exams

Objectives: To equip the cadets with drill, arm drill, firing capacity required to appear for the certificate exams

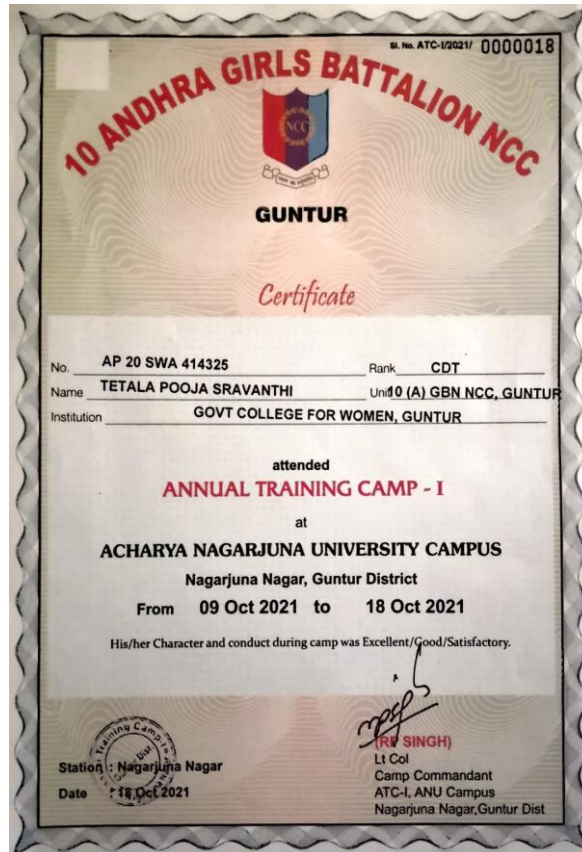



Description: During this academic year 2021-22, nineteen final year cadets appeared for C-certificate examination on 05.03.2022 and 06.03.2022 for practical's and theory respectively. Twenty one second year cadets appeared for 'B' certificate examination conducted on 19.02.2022 and 20.02.2022 for practical's and theory respectively .

Outcome: 16 out of 19 passed the "C" certificate examination (95%)

20 out of 21 passed the "B" certificate examination (84%)

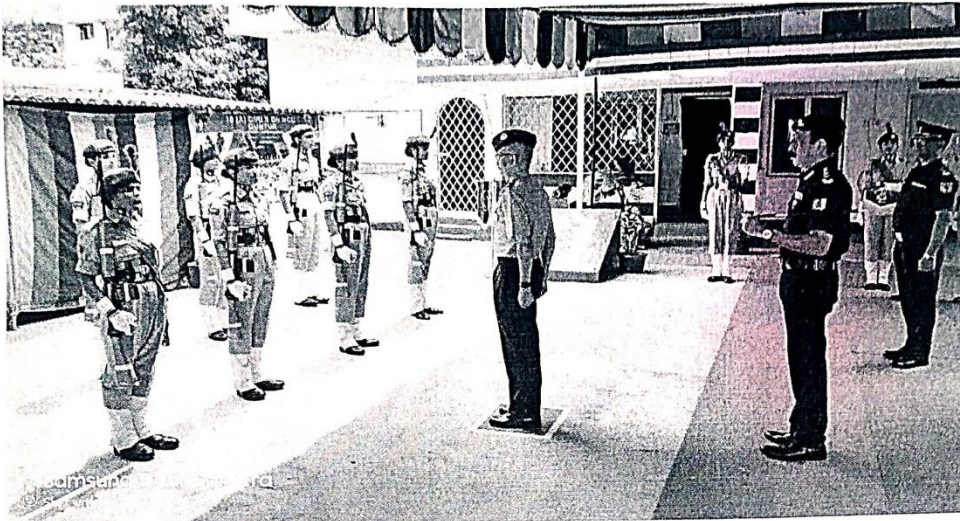
Activity-20**Guard of honour to DDG at Bn**
