Objectives:

- To select participants for the district level Yuva Utsav, leading to state and national level youth festivals.
- To promote youth talent in various artistic and cultural fields.
- To encourage youth participation in events aligned with the India@2047 theme.

Brief Description of the Activity

NSS Unit 1, in collaboration with the NYK District Youth Office, organized the block level Yuva Utsav competitions at the Government College for Women in Guntur. The event aimed to select participants for district-level competitions, with winners having the opportunity to advance to state and national level youth festivals. The overall theme for the competitions was "*India@2047 - Panch Pran of Amrit Kaal.*"

The competitions included various categories such as poetry, painting/art, declamation, cultural/dance, and photography. The participants competed with enthusiasm, showcasing their creativity and talent in their respective categories.

The program was coordinated by Smt. M. Santosh Kumari and Kum D. Kiran Mai, with winners selected to participate at the district level, state level and National level

Outcomes:

NSS Unit 1 volunteers achieved significant success, securing 1st place in declamation, 2nd place at the district level for essay writing and painting, with additional 2nd and 3rd place awards in other categories. The prize amounts awarded at the district level Yuva Utsav were Rs 5000 for the declamation winner, and Rs 2500 each for the winners in painting, essay writing, and dance.

The prizes for District level winners were presented by Member of Parliament (MP) Alla Ayodhya Rami Reddy during the district-level festival at Hindu college, Guntur marking the conclusion of the event.

. Among the notable winners, Kumari P. Priyasri of NSS Unit 1 was selected for declamation at the district, state, and national levels, eventually participated in the national youth festival at Nasik.

- The event successfully identified talented youth for participation in district, state, and national level youth festivals.
- The event served as a stepping stone for further involvement in the national youth festival.

The block level Yuva Utsav competitions provided a valuable opportunity for youth with winners advancing to further levels of the Yuva Utsav especially for participation of P;Priya sri in National youth festival at Nasik, Maharashtra

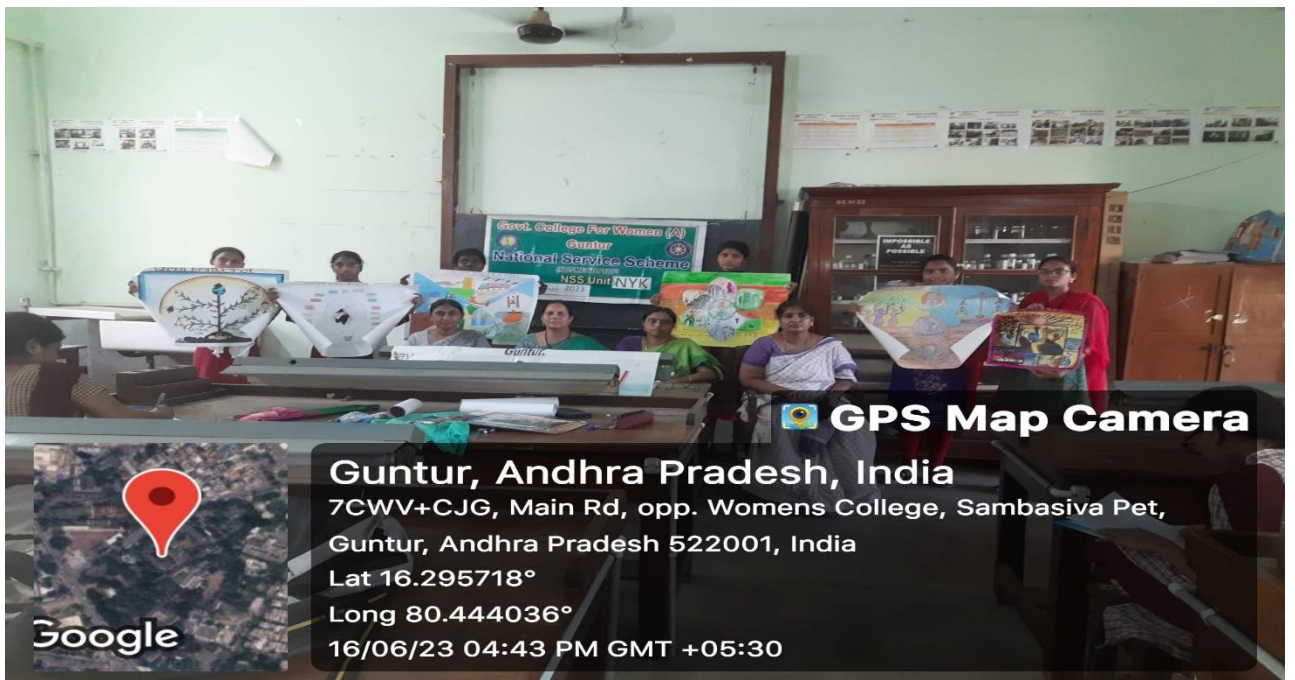

2. Encouraged students and faculty to adopt yoga as a regular practice for stress relief and overall health improvement.







- The collaboration with an NGO highlighted the community's support for nationalistic activities.

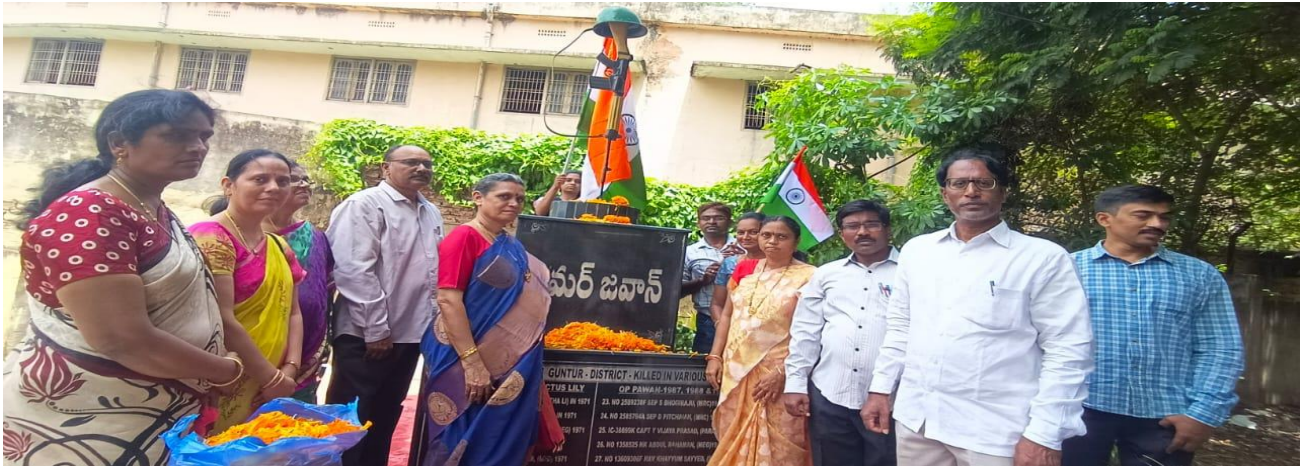

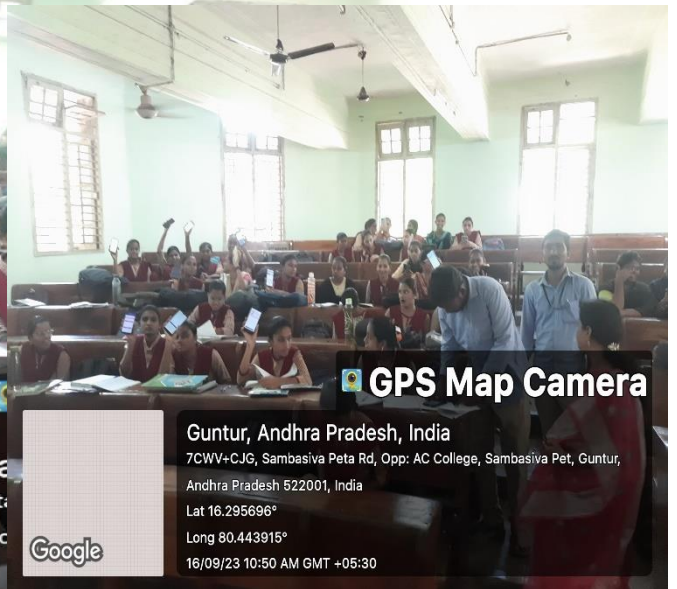

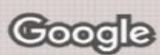

Outcomes:

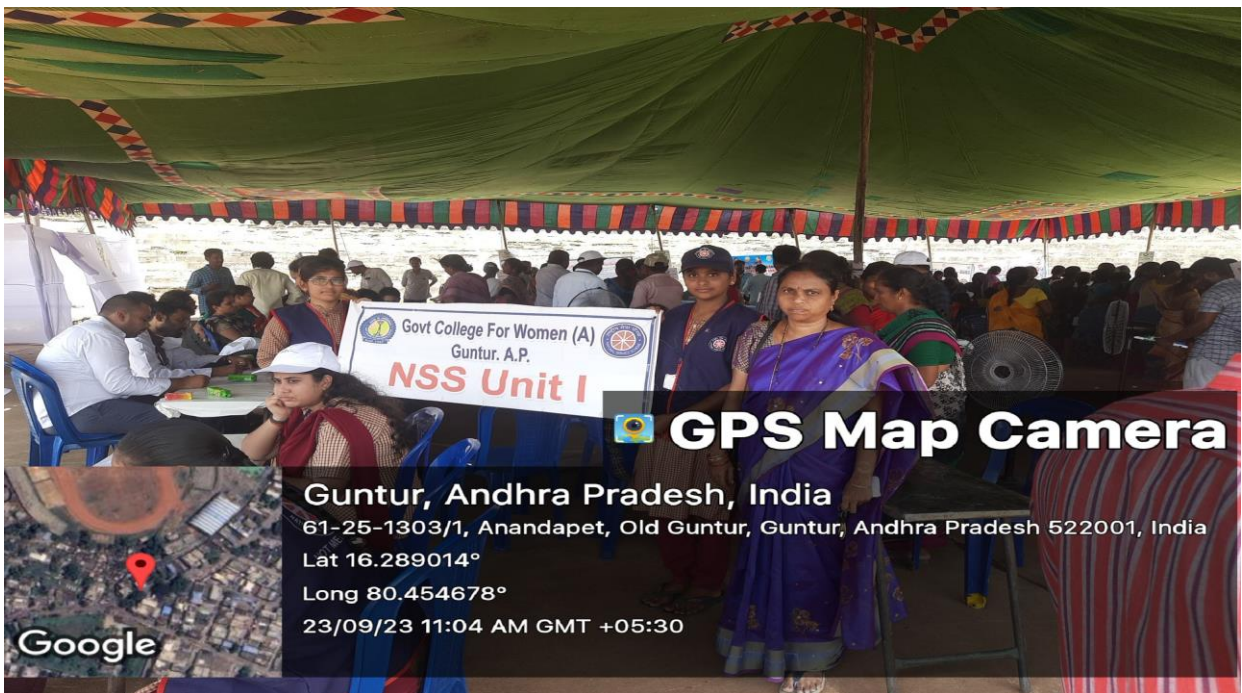

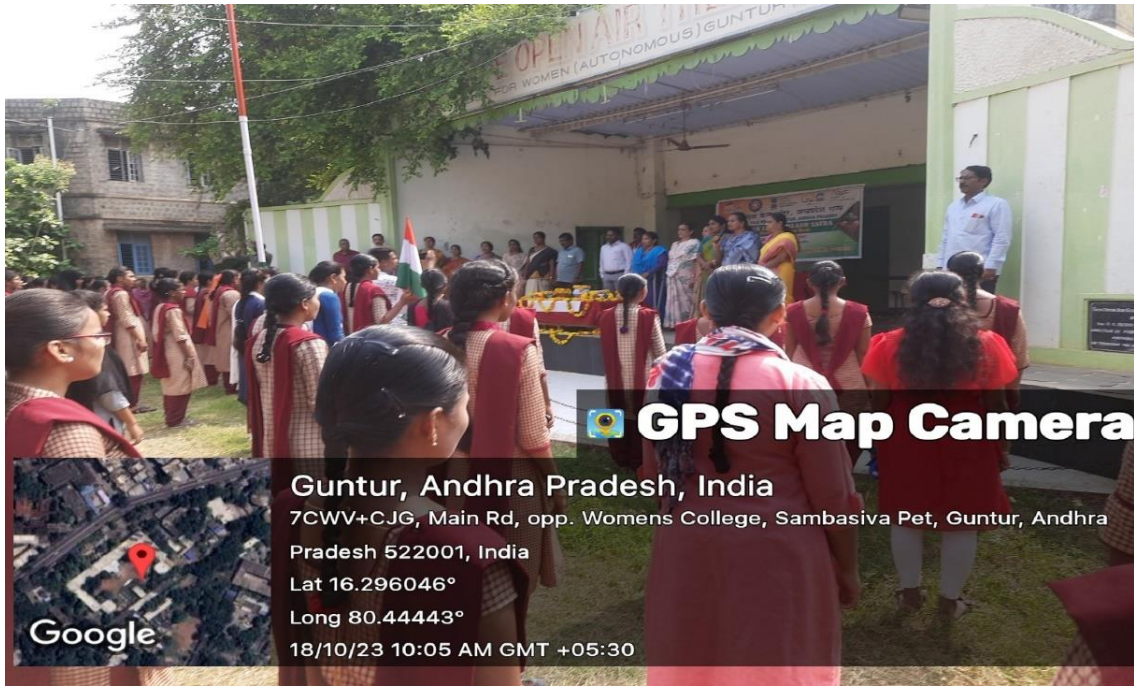
Outcomes

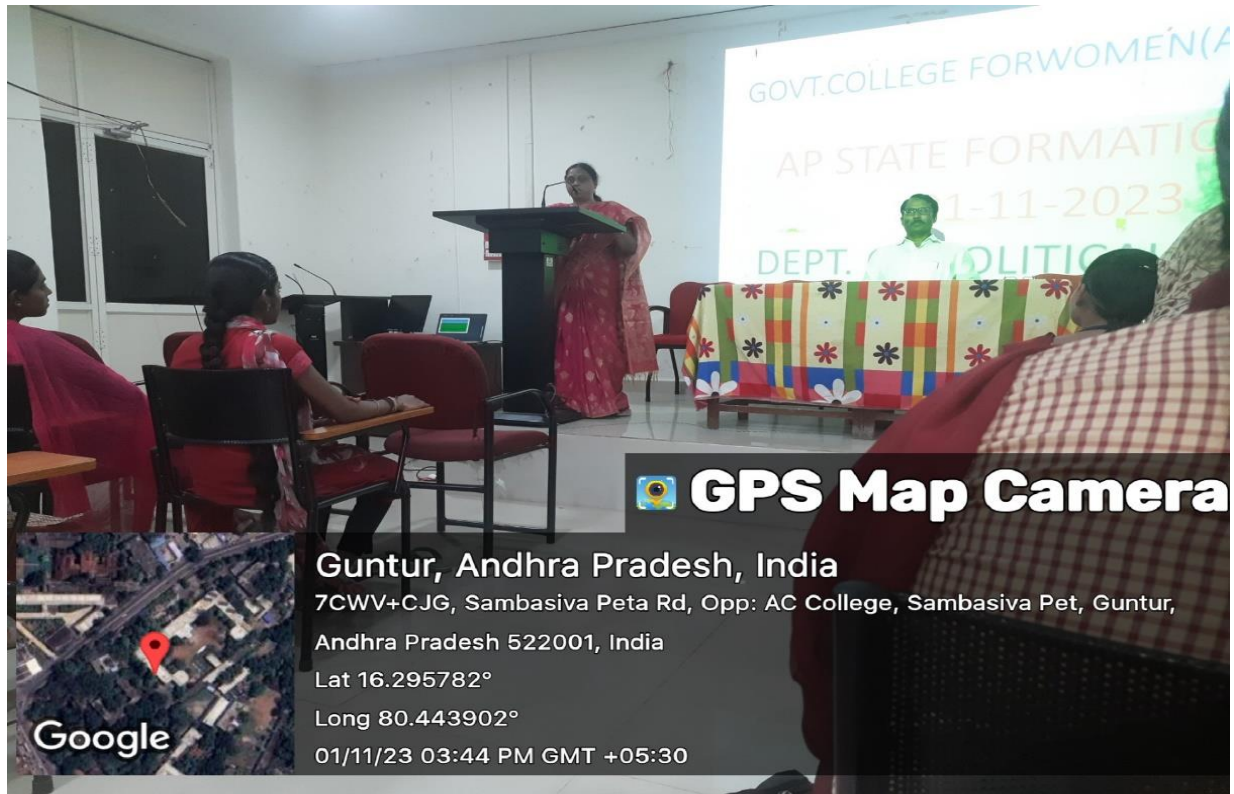

4. Empowerment of students and community members to take proactive steps in preventing HIV/AIDS and supporting individuals affected by the disease.



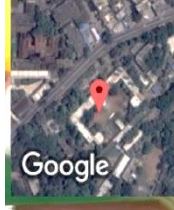

This Financial Literacy Competition not only empowered students with essential financial skills but also served as a platform for fostering a culture of financial responsibility and awareness in the community.

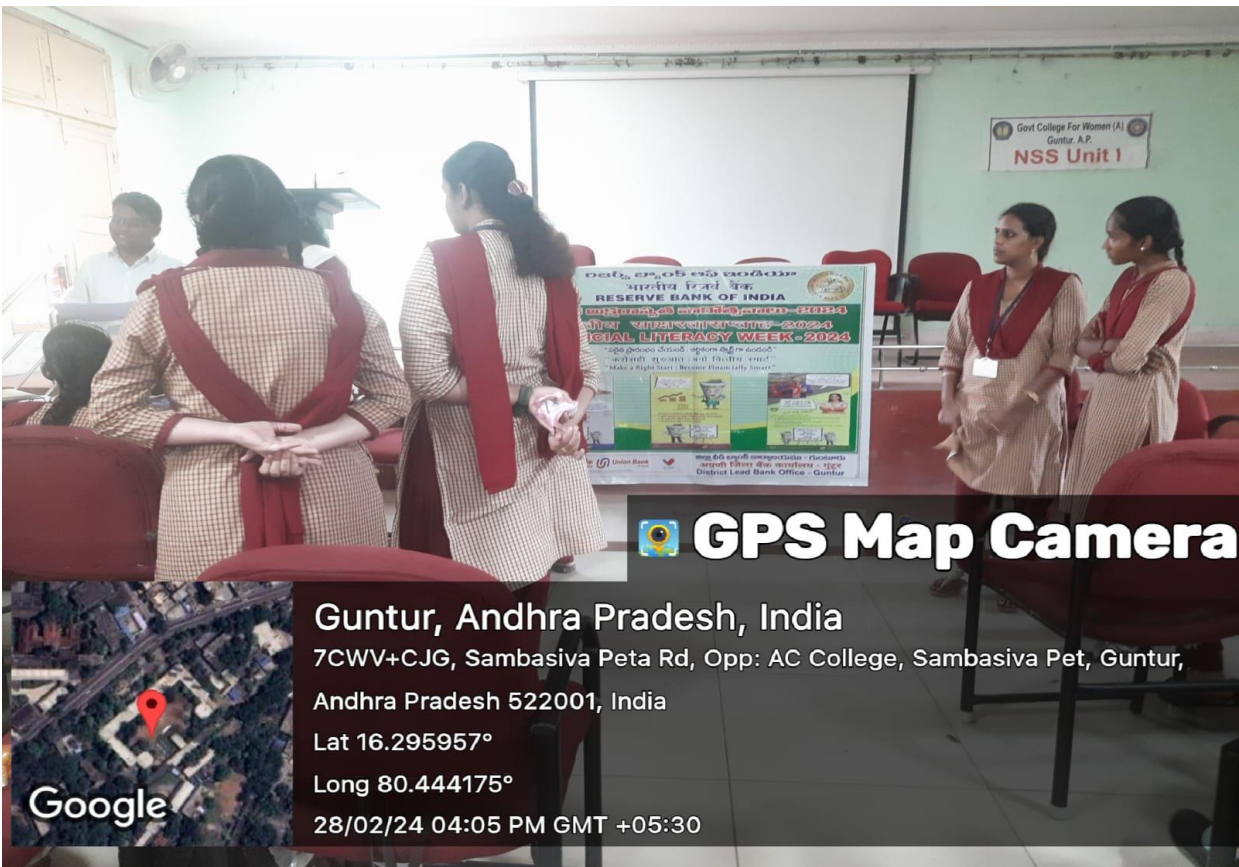

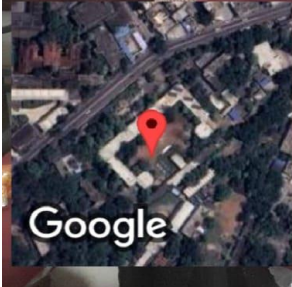

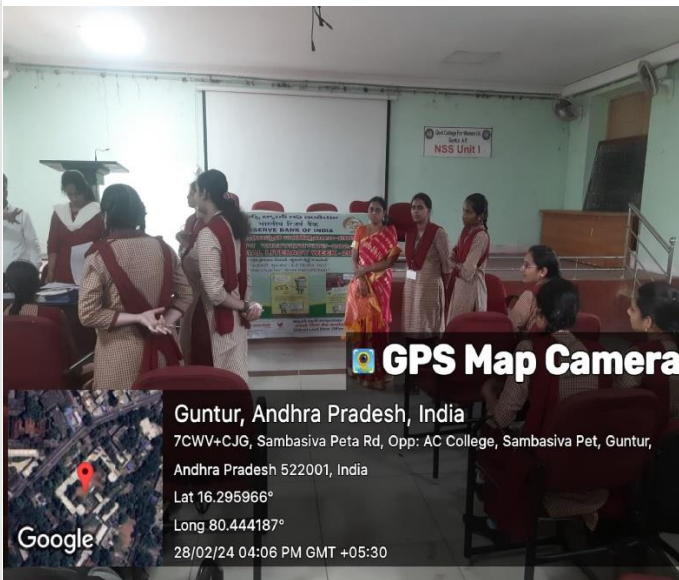
